

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE REPORT

Friday, November 16, 2007

Report respectfully presented to council from the Committee of the Whole meeting held on Friday, November 16, 2007, in Council Chambers at 14:00h.

1. Reports
 - a. Disposal Sites – reports reviewed;

It was noted that there was no garbage pickup in DR for October and only 2 visits at the same site. Committee has asked for this to be clarified with the attendant.

- b. Recycling – reports reviewed;

It was queried by a council member that tin was going into the hole and was answered that it was still attached to some item (wood). Committee member asked if we are still going to look into a covered area to set aside recyclable items. Some discussion on other sites (New Zealand, and sites farther south of us) on how they handle this and that it would not be happening. Plot recycling stats during Campground openings to see if there is a surge in items.

- c. Fire Training – reports reviewed; NO REPORT GIVEN

- d. Working Document (Financial) – reports received;

Council Honorariums See “to date” amount- Is this correct. Also check the remaining to pay. Need to make adjustments.

Deux Rivieres Site Closure – Committee member was concerned that no amount is entered here and would not like to see a large bill come forth and be queried as to being more than what is allotted....Wondered if any bills have been received, if not can we request that invoices be submitted by Mr. Stewart - What is the total cost for 2007. What Stage is Mr. Stewart at? What more is left to be done? Is the amount under RIII 65205.00 for the DR dump site only?

2. Unfinished Business –

CPAC : ATVs are not allowed – Committee member asked if there was any response by CPAC committee and the answer they gave was If there is no by-law they (ATVs) are not allowed on the road and can be fined

JEC Committee member asked if the lawyer was MR. LeConte and the reply was yes. See Item 3 paragraph B of report.

3. New Business

a. Fire lagniappes

There was a fair discussion here to determine how to handle this re Clerk's report. This year it is recommended that \$75.00 be paid to 14 volunteers. Then a policy needs to be written to cover 2008 and beyond with guidelines as how to determine what to pay to whom. Councillor Gibson will draft a policy for the next Committee meeting for discussion. Councillor Reid mentioned that the new policy when written and approved should be given to each volunteer and this should be completed by January 2008 as a draft. Please add this to the next agenda for this committee.

b. Missing Link and fill for Bissett Creek Disposal Site

Culvert in on Bissett Creek Road will have some fill to dispose of when job is completed and it is recommended by this committee that it be stored at the BC dump for future use at same dump.

Blocking access to DR site – sometimes the gate is open - Who has the key to the unofficial lock? DO we need road access or should we take the road out? Rocks are in place but can we ditch the area to stop driving in? Where will Carol park when she stops to wait for garbage after opening or will this be discontinued? - JP2G may need access for testing?

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. That fire lagniappes be paid as in 2006.
2. That the fill from the Missing Link's project on Bissett Creek Road be accepted at the Bissett Landfill for future use.
