THE CORPORATION OF THE UNITED TOWNSHIPS OF HEAD, CLARA & MARIA

BY-LAW NUMBER 2008-05

BEING a by-law to delegate the discretionary powers and duties of Council.

WHEREAS under the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, (the Act) Section 8, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS under the Act as amended by Bill 130 in 2007, every municipality shall adopt a policy with respect to the delegation of its powers and duties;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria wishes to make known its position on delegation of its authority;

AND WHEREAS in a municipality of this size, the workload for Council is such that it is not important that Council delegate any of its powers and duties above the general administrative authority that it is required to delegate or has previously delegated through job descriptions, hiring by-laws, procurement by-laws, agreements with County for planning services, and other such specific arrangements;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria does enact as follows:

- 1. THAT the Council of the Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria retains the rights to its traditional powers and duties as allowed under the *Municipal Act* (and others) and not specifically delegated through by-laws, job descriptions, appointments or other agreements and does not delegate any new powers as allowed under the amendments to the *Municipal Act*.
- 2. **THAT** this by-law come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing;
