

**THE CORPORATION OF THE UNITED TOWNSHIPS OF HEAD,  
CLARA & MARIA**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 2008- 06**

**BEING** a by-law adopting a Road Construction Minimum Standards policy.

**WHEREAS** under the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, Section 8, a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, provides that Section 8 and 11 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to (a) enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and (b) enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it appropriate that a Road Construction Minimum Standards policy be created and adopted for use by staff and the public of the municipality to ensure consistency in construction and adherence to Municipal, County and Provincial policy;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria does enact as follows:

1. **THAT** the Road Construction Minimum Standards policy, as outlined in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made part of this By-law be adopted by Council.
2. **THAT** the Clerk and the Road Superintendent shall be jointly responsible for the administration of this By-law and will be accountable to Council for its enforcement.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall not be interpreted to contradict or violate any statute or regulation of the Province of Ontario or the County of Renfrew Official Plan.
4. **THAT** this by-law come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing;

**READ** a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> time this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 2008.

**READ** a 3<sup>rd</sup> time short and finally passed this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 2008.
