

Schedule "A" to by law 2008-29

ALCOHOL POLICY

Goal:

The Council of the Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria wishes to provide a policy for responsible management practices. The Council also wishes to reduce and/or avoid alcohol related problems in order that people may enjoy our facilities in a manner that encourages the health and safety of the participants and the protection of the public and facilities and the Corporation.

Definitions:

In this policy the following definition applies;

Alcohol(ic) means spirits, wine or beer or any combination thereof and includes any product of fermentation or distillation in a form appropriate for human consumption as a beverage, alone or in combination with another matter.

Controls:

1. The lessee of the hall is responsible for getting the correct permit(s) for the event being held.
2. The lessee is responsible for seeing that all provincial laws and regulations as well as the municipal alcohol policy are strictly followed (a copy of some of the regulations will be available at the bar).
3. No one person may purchase more than 4 alcoholic drinks at a time.
4. There will be a log of all incidents and decisions regarding service kept at each event ie. Photo identification requests, refusals to serve patrons, incidents of discord.
5. To avoid overcrowding the hall limit is 90.
6. A wide range of non alcoholic drinks and food will be available.
7. A poster displaying a partial outline of relevant laws, regulations and policies, the current license and the alcohol invoice will be posted in a conspicuous place.
8. Any person or groups hosting an event where alcohol is served must staff with servers trained in Server Intervention and responsible server techniques.

FAILURE TO COMPLY

Any individual or group's failure to comply with this policy may result in the municipality reporting to the legal authorities and/or refusal of future use of the facilities.
