Final report for the hall extension.

The final numbers are detailed below. The bottom line is that the project was completed on time and within budget with few challenges other than with the architect and engineers transferring our ideas to workable plans. Letters of dissatisfaction and a request for partial refunds have been forwarded to both firms.

Total costs amounted to \$269,060.63 which includes all construction, appliances and equipment, all found projects and most wish list items.

Although the total is somewhat above the \$258,505 specifically approved in July, it is well within the total of \$326,660 which we had available for use and approved for cost overruns, wish list items and found projects in resolution number 18/07/13/006 dated July 18, 2013.

The overage of \$10,555.63 included floor to ceiling closets, back steps, rebuild of kitchen floor, installation of steel over bar opening, re-flooring the entire hall, door locks and keys – for the entire building including the garage, a project long overdue.

As a reminder, the following is a portion of the resolution passed in July of 2013 authorizing the utilization of surpluses, reserves and Gas Tax Funds to complete additional projects during the original renovation.

- staff is directed to work with the contractor to include as many "wish list" items as
 possible while keeping within approved funding;
- the replacement of the furnace be pursued as a separate project;
- Council authorize staff to spend \$4,650 from the 2012 unallocated surplus to pay for architectural and engineering costs and \$52,000 from the 2012 audited surplus and \$67,000 from the hall/office reserves to pay for remaining heating costs and wish list items.

BACKGROUND/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- 1. An estimated 275 300 hours of volunteer labour was used to complete the project mainly in areas of demolition, framing, insulation, sanding and painting.
- 2. The \$258,505 below includes the furnace costs not originally included in the grant funding of approximately \$30,000 (including transfer to propane).
