Open letter from *Children First* to the Chairman of the Renfrew County District School Board, Roy Reiche

Re: Future of Morison School

We wrote to you *four weeks ago* and have not received a reply, or even the courtesy of an acknowledgement.

In the interest of genuine transparency, we have three requests:

- 1. Allow public access to the written sheets handed out at the three consultation meetings in Deep River.
- 2. Provide separate written reports of the three consultation meetings.
- 3. Explain why your staff concluded that Option 1 (close the Morison site) was favoured, whereas our public opinion survey resulted in Option 1 being rejected by more than 90% of the respondents 99 votes out of 108; and even if the 29 votes of Morison parents were subtracted from the total, Option 1 would still be rejected by 88% of the respondents.

There is a clear implication that although Board staff sought input from the public, they did not trust the public to make a wise decision, and therefore did not ask for a written preference at the consultation meetings. Option 1 may be in the best interests of Morison students, but according to our public opinion survey, it may not be; and in addition, Option 2 may not cost as much as Option 1. Let's find out!

It should be noted that the October 26<sup>th</sup> Action Report submitted by Board staff stated that: "Given the criteria on which the grant is provided, two options were to be considered". On the basis of that statement, we assumed that the two options were equally viable; and we also assumed that the citizens of Deep River would have significant influence on the choice to be made, by participating in a consultation process that provided an adequate explanation of how those options would affect the community.

Finally, our letter isn't the only one to be ignored. I am aware of letters from the Morison School Council, Anne Davies and Alex Frew which were never answered.
