Subject: A recommended update to the municipal fire plan and procedures.

RECOMMENDATION: That Council approve the recommended plan and changes to procedures to better protect staff and facility user safety.

WHEREAS the current Fire Safety Plan is outdated and ineffective;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria are extremely concerned with the health and safety of the employees and the users of the community facility;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE Fire Plan and Procedures be adopted as presented to be implemented immediately.

BACKGROUND/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: This is pretty self-explanatory. Staff noticed the current posted plan in the community hall and noted that it needed prompt attention. The accompanying document is the new public notice, the new plan and new procedures for the municipal offices.

Requirements:

- 1. Install smoke alarms in the community hall, the front office and the library.
- 2. Implement Fire Drill procedures so that staff are familiar with the procedure to follow in the event of a fire in the office, library and/or hall during office hours and outside of office hours.
- 3. Create and post a map of the entire building with fire extinguisher locations.
 - a. Train staff on locations;
 - b. Provide a copy with the hall rental agreement.
- 4. Determine a meeting location for office staff during office hours.
- 5. Determine a meeting location for hall users outside of office hours.

Financial Considerations/Budget Impact: None really – aside from installation of smoke alarms.

Policy Impact: Creates new policy.
