THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria does hereby agree to support the Township of Uxbridge in their cause and respectfully call upon the Federal Minister of Industry Canada, the Honourable Christian Paradis to immediately amend spectrum auction rules to allow for the separate auction of rural from urban spectrum, thereby allowing rural Canadians in areas with low population density to access high-speed internet via licensed spectrum.
