Subject:

1. Time since the last meeting has largely been spent on the following:
 - a. Fire Safety and Emergency Management displays and draws for June Jazaar – annual compliance for promotion and education.
 - b. Follow up for various projects: boat launches, healthy kids, Canada Day
 - c. Employee meetings
 - d. Transfer of waste management processes/collections.
2. There has been suggestions from our consultant to have the province pay for its own bins for recycling and garbage at Driftwood and Brent Campground. In larger communities businesses have always arranged for their own collection of waste through private business into large bins. Our situation is different. It is staff recommendation that if Council wishes to move in this direction that at least one year's notice be provided of the change so their staff have time to plan.
3. Work is progressing on submitting application for amendment to the certificates for the disposal sites. MOE has advised that they will not consider granting interim changes until the applications have been submitted.
4. As you have likely learned through newsletters – recycling will change to Beauman's on July 1, 2016 with Bill to begin collection of recycling in Mackey and Stonecliffe. The only changes for residents is that Styrofoam will no longer be collected. Residents should have already been separating fibre (paper/cardboard) from all other materials. Plastic bags should have been bags of bags. Most other materials will remain the same.
5. Bag tags for those who have not picked theirs up will be mailed this week.
6. We have had one applicant for the summer student so it is anticipated that Sneh Patel will begin to work with us on Homecoming and our social media presence later this month.
