## BACKGROUND/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Currently, the Terms of Reference for the Public Works Advisory Committee states that the committee shall be comprised of up to four members of the public. Council may choose to amend the Terms of Reference to allow for more than four members to sit on the committee, in order to best use the resources that have been offered. Allowing additional members to sit on the committee will increase the amount of experience, advice and ideas brought forth by the committee. On the contrary, it may be felt that having too many members may hinder business of the committee. For reference purposes, the Recreation

Advisory Committee allows five members of the public, two members of Council as well as public guests who may contribute ideas to the committee.

## OPTIONS/DISCUSSION:

Council may amend the current Terms of Reference to include more than four members on the committee; or
Council may not amend the Terms of Reference to include additional members. In that case, only four appointments may be made to the committee and will have to be chosen among the seven applications received. Each application received has been included with this report for this reason.
