It has also been decided to eliminate garbage bag tags starting in the New Year 2021. The bag tags have served their purpose in creating awareness of reducing waste and improving recycling rates. The majority of our users have proven their understanding of the need to prolong the life of our landfill sites. Please keep in mind that the regulation of 1 bag per week for each household and 4 bags per week for business is still in force.

We certainly have been missing our usual annual Recreation and Library Board events. At this time last year, I was congratulating our volunteers on their successful Christmas Market, Card Party fundraisers and the children's Halloween Party. Despite the pandemic, I know the strong spirit of volunteerism lives on in HCM and that these activities will be back better than ever when we are able to do so safely.

My thanks to the Public Works Advisory Committee who have been able to continue their meetings while following public health guidelines. I have been lucky enough to accompany this "rowdy" group on road tours of our municipality from parks to landfill sites, cemeteries to boat launches and more. I am very grateful for their volunteer efforts to make our community a better place.

Special Meeting of Council Saturday December 12th at 1:00 pm

This month marks the midpoint of the Council's term in office. It is my hope that we have been able to make decisions that are in the best interest of the municipality as a whole. It is our mandate to operate in an accountable and transparent manner. As such, your Council is holding a Special Meeting to decide on the 17 (+) recommendations that were presented in the Final Service Delivery Report by Maclaren Municipal Consulting Inc.

I am very pleased (from p. 4 of the report) that there were 66 individual responses to the online survey which is an excellent response from 110 households - 47 respondents were year-round residents, 17 seasonal and 1 was not a resident. The respondents' households included 157 individuals.

The upcoming meeting is, as all of our Council meetings open to the public. In addition to the online survey conducted we welcome your feedback on the final report. Please see the notice below for information. All deputations will be no longer than 5 minutes.
