Mayor's Message

The beautiful sunny crisp cold days of March are upon us. I am sure that all of our citizens are enjoying the winter weather and also celebrating that our region is now been declared a "green" zone once again. It is great to enjoy a little more freedom but we must also remain vigilant. In a recent media release from the Renfrew County District Health Unit Dr. Cushman has expressed his concerns about emerging trends in the Barry's Bay area.

"Renfrew County has been classified as a Green Zone for over a week now. Businesses are finally getting the chance to open again, to employ their workers, and to serve their customers delayed needs. The last thing we want to do is to jeopardize our status and clamp down yet again on the economy, or possibly implement more stringent rules in the neighbourhood of Barry's Bay compared to elsewhere in RCD,"

"This is concerning as it will be a challenge with forecasts of a third wave driven by COVID-19 variants that are more infectious and spread quicker than the original strains of the virus. Constant attention needs to be paid to masking, distancing and proper hygiene. Moreover, what stands out amongst the latest cases is the number of contacts and the additional spread. COVID-19 is a very social virus, especially the new strains and it goes without saying that we need strict adherence to our household and workplace contacts to limit the spread," states Dr. Cushman.
